











Fly a Kite Behavior Incentive

To prepare this, cut out the six kites and cover them with clear contact paper. On your classroom wall, put masking tape at six-inch intervals going from the floor to the ceiling. Put the four kites at the bottom mark near the floor with plastic tac.

At the beginning of your class, divide the children into six teams. Tell them we want to see which team can get their kite flying the highest by the end of class. Throughout the time, move the kites up and down, depending on how good or bad that team is. Give a treat to the team who gets their kite highest at the end of the day.
