### Hungry Brothers

To prepare the game, cut out Joseph's eleven brothers and Joseph's silver cup. Cover them with clear contact paper and tape each brother to a paper cup with some coins in it (to represent the coins in the brothers' sacks of grain). You can also put some grain in the cups if you like (rice or cracked wheat). Add the silver cup that you cut out to one of these cups.

To play the game, tell the children that even though Joseph's brothers had treated him badly, he chose to forgive them. When they were hungry, he filled their bags with grain and gave their money back. Divide the class into two teams. Ask a review question. The child who stands and answers correctly gets to search one of the brother's "sacks of grain." He may take the money he finds there to his team. Keep answering questions until all of the "sacks" have been opened (the child who finds Joseph's silver cup gets to add an extra dollar to his team's total!). Total the amount of money each team collected to see which team has the most.
