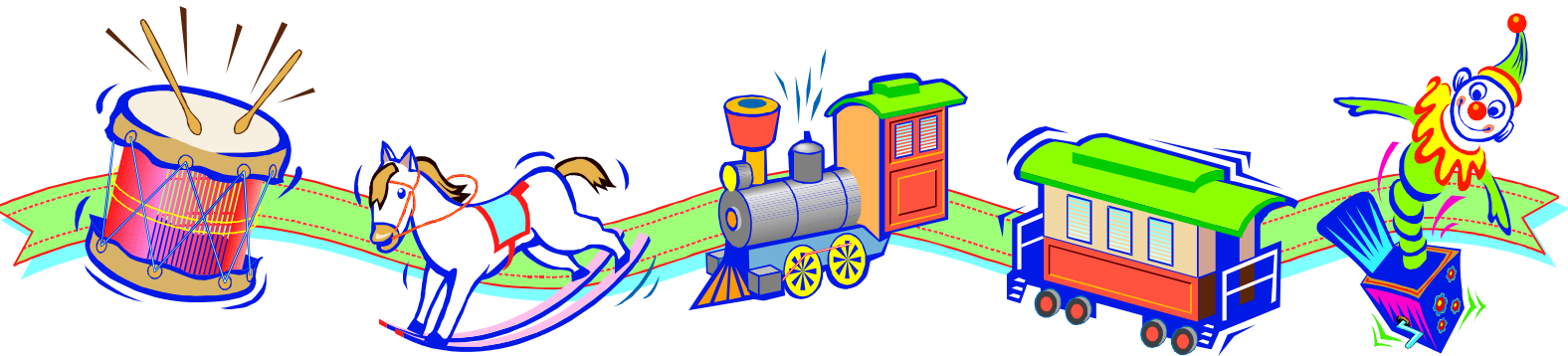
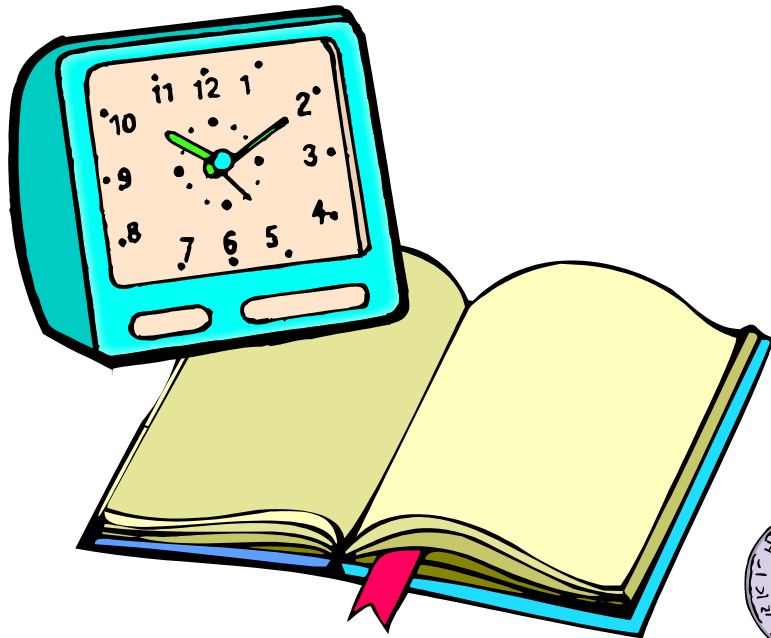

# What is Christian Stewardship?

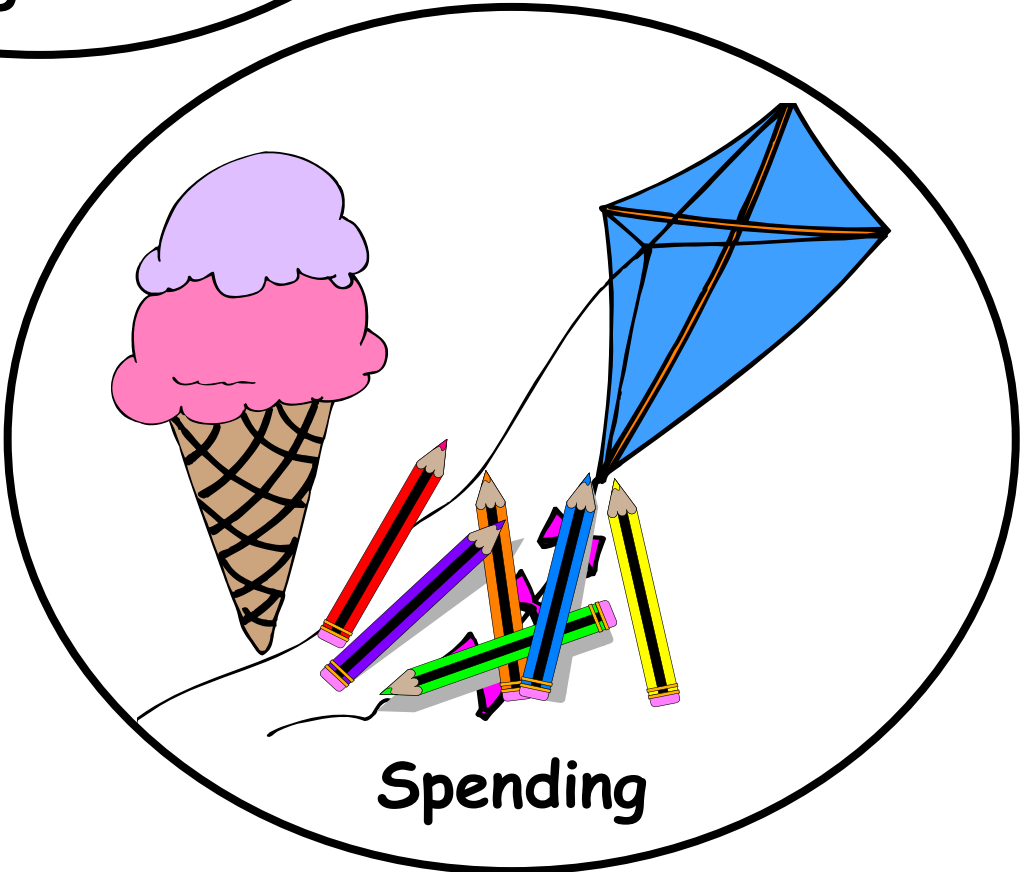

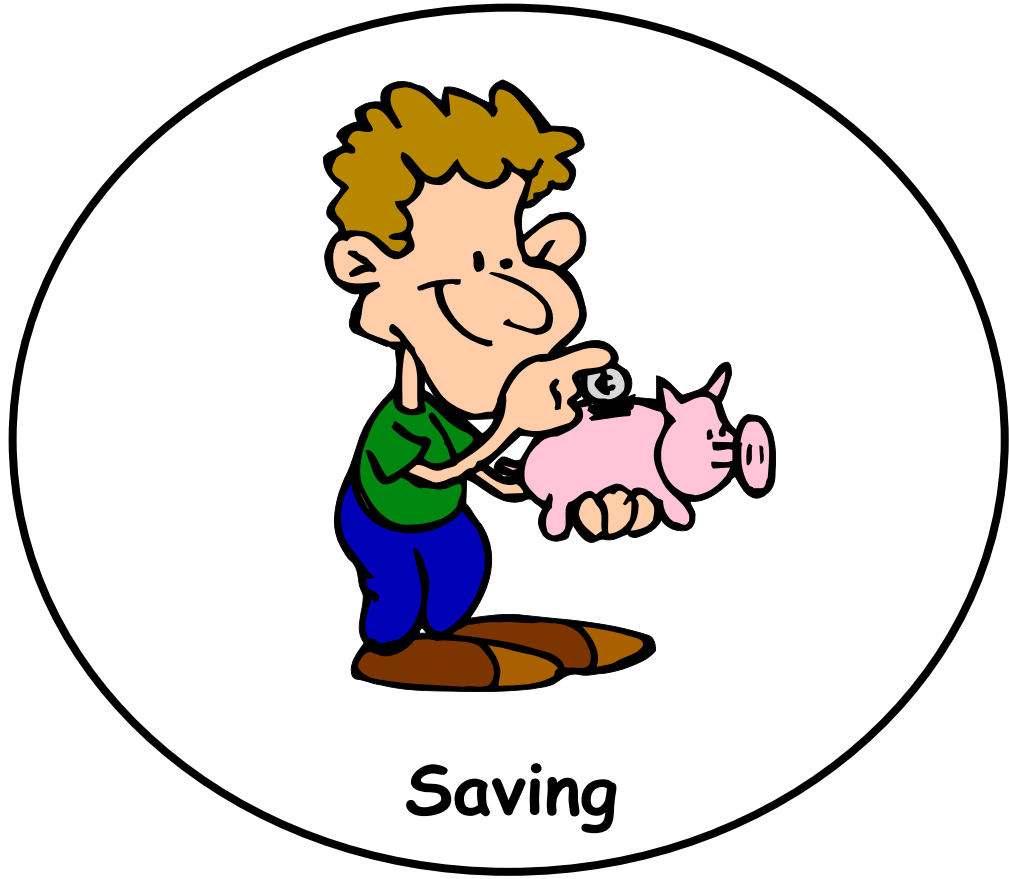

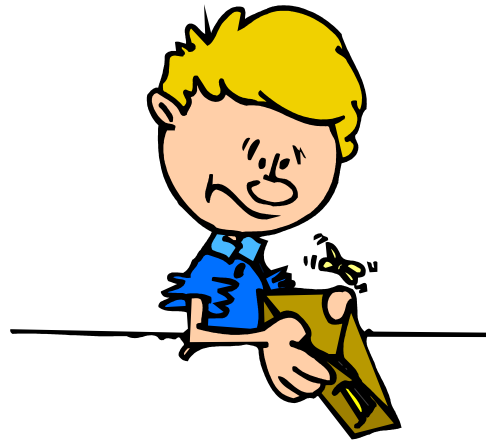
**God's Principles

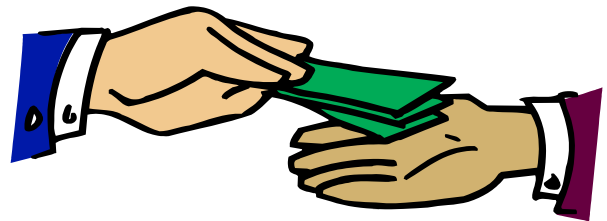

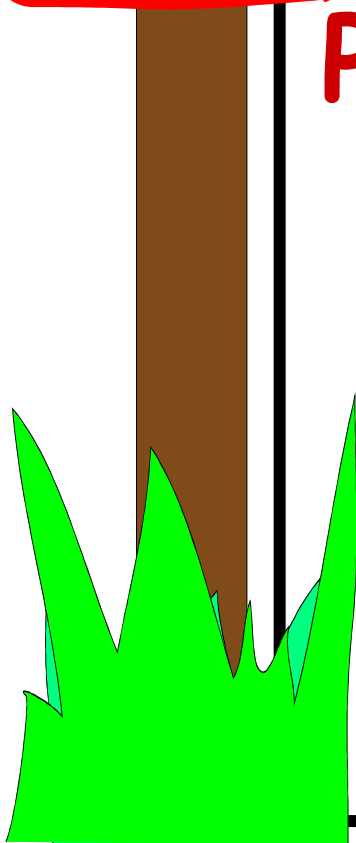
